At the same time, MNBC also acknowledges the complicated and challenging historical relationship between Métis people, and indeed all Indigenous people, with the office of the Crown.

MNBC views this day as an opportunity to focus on the upcoming National Day of Truth and Reconciliation and honours those families impacted by colonization and residential schools.
