

### **Tenancy Application Form**

MNBC's residential housing properties support Métis citizens by providing them with secure and affordable housing. Tenants of MNBC will also gain access to any available community and cultural amenities and services during their tenancy.

#### The applicant must:

- be an MNBC citizen\*, verified by providing a copy of their MNBC citizenship card\* or citizenship number\*\*;
- be 19 years of age or older;
- have a family size no larger than the maximum allowed under CMHC housing suitability guidelines; (see below – Under the Standard)<sup>1</sup>
- have no more than 2 small pets;
- be willing to consent to a credit check if required;
- · be willing to accept and follow tenancy rules; and
- have the ability to live independently.

\*Under circumstances where there are no applicants with MNBC citizenship, MNBC will consider members of Chartered Communities without MNBC citizenship, followed by Indigenous individuals and families. MNBC may request documentation to verify membership in a MNBC Chartered Community or Inuit or First Nations status.

\*\*Applicants with a valid MNBC citizenship card are asked to provide a copy of their card alongside their application to Century 21 to expedite the verification process.

- A maximum of 2 persons per bedroom.
- Household members, of any age, living as part of a married or common-law couple share a bedroom with their spouse or common-law partner.
- Lone parents, of any age, have a separate bedroom from their children.
- Household members aged 18 or over have a separate bedroom, except those living as part of a married or common-law couple.
- Household members under 18 years of age of the same sex may share a bedroom, except lone parents and those living as part of a married or common-law couple.
- Household members under 5 years of age of the opposite sex may share a bedroom if doing so would reduce the number of required bedrooms. This situation would arise only in households with an odd number of males under 18, and odd number of females under 18 and at least one female and one male under the age of 5.

An exception to the above is a household consisting of 1 individual living alone who may live in a studio apartment with no separate bedroom.

- The applicant agrees that MNBC may collect data and contact them from time to time for the purpose of conducting any tenant-related surveys.
- The applicant(s) understands that this application does not obligate MNBC to approve funding or approve their application for tenancy.
- All applicants who give personal information to MNBC shall be required to consent to the release of that
  information to MNBC to comply with the BC <u>Personal Information Protection Act</u> (PIPA) and <u>Freedom</u>
  of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (FIPPA).

#### Consent:

- The applicant(s) gives consent to MNBC and its agents to verify and disclose any of the information given in this application form for internal purposes or to other agencies for any of the following reasons:
  - to confirm household income;
  - to confirm eligibility for the program;
  - audit purposes; and/or
  - referral to other programs within MNBC or outside service providers.
- The applicant(s) consents to release the information provided in this application to MNBC, and
  understands this information will be used in accordance with the <u>BC Personal Information Protection</u>
  Act (PIPA) and <u>Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act</u> (FIPPA).
